

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (BATH ROAD A430/A38/B4008)  
(PARISHES OF HARDWICKE, HUNTS GROVE, HARESFIELD AND STANDISH)  
(STROUD DISTRICT) ORDER 2023**

Notice is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council in exercise of its enabling powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intend to make the above-named order the effect of which will be to reduce the speed limit to 50mph on the following roads:

<b>Road Name &amp; Number</b>	<b>Extent</b>
Bath Road (A430)	From its junction with the Cross Keys roundabout for approximately 500 metres in a south easterly direction.
Bath Road (A38)	From a point approximately 500 metres south-east of its junction with the Cross Keys roundabout in a north-westerly direction to the Cross Keys roundabout.
Bath Road (B4008)	From its junction with Mount Farm Lane (401322) in a south-easterly direction to a point approximately 310 metres north of its junction with The Lane to Warren Farm (501136) to join up with the existing 50mph speed limit.

The lengths of roads fall within the Parishes of Hardwicke, Hunts Grove, Haresfield and Standish within the District of Stroud in the County of Gloucestershire.
