Message from Crest Nicholson

HUNTS GROVE UPDATE SEPTEMBER 2025



Dear residents,

Work on the primary Hunts Grove access (A38 junction) is continuing to make strong progress and is largely running as planned. However, as with all large infrastructure projects, there are variables outside of our control, such as:

- Street light issues: late design approval which delayed procurement of lights.
- Traffic signal issues: late design approval.
- Additional works to bridge, and drainage run for B4008, requested by GCC.
- Note: incoming power is progressing but final design is yet to be confirmed.

As a result, and in collaboration with GCC, National Highways and other stakeholders, the Traffic Management Plan for the A38 Southern Connector works (to Hunts Grove) has been revised. The main points to note are:

- The B4008 slip road off the A38 towards Green Lane will remain closed until 19/12/25 for safety purposes.
- The flyover will remain closed until 19/12/25 but there will be traffic management on the A38 for the duration.

As previously advised, a night closure (8pm to 6am) is planned between Cross Keys and Waterwells roundabouts, from 8/12/25 to 12/12/25. Businesses at Quedgeley West Business Park have been notified about traffic escort arrangements.

The programme is still targeting completion by Friday, 19 December 2025, with full opening the following day. Diversion routes throughout the works will be clearly signed. Please refer to the Traffic Management Plan for further details.
